

RE: YOUR ENQUIRY REGARDING CAT D1 DRIVER TRAINING

Thank you for your enquiry regarding CAT D1 Driver training with Lloyds School of Motoring.

To get started you should now make the following arrangements:

1. Book a medical with your GP and ensure you bring the Medical Form (DLM1) for your GP to complete. (Costing at the discretion of your GP and is only valid for 3 months.)
2. Complete an Access NI Basic Disclosure online and wait for the letter of clearance to arrive before posting to DVLNI Coleraine. (Fee - £26.00) – only valid for 3 months.

3. Complete the DL2 form and send it, together with the above documents and 2 parts of your licence to the DVLNI (Fee - £20.00). Please note that processing can take some 8 weeks.

In the meantime, you should start preparations for the Theory and Hazard Perception tests. Please note you can purchase the most up to date theory book and hazard perception DVD from the office. (Fee - £15.00 Each).

4. Contact Lloyds School of Motoring for assistance in training for your Theory and Hazard Perception tests (if required).
5. Book and pass Theory and Hazard Perception tests (Fee - £37.00):

6. Once steps 1-5 above are complete, you will be ready for your practical training.
7. Please also note you will be required to complete CPC Module 2 (Fee £23.00) -study book can be purchased from the office (Fee £15.00) & CPC Module 4 if you wish to use your newly acquired licence to drive for hire and reward. After completing the CPC you will be issued with a Driver Qualification Card.

Starter packs, with the relevant forms named above, are available for collection from the office.
